she pointed to her "husband."




This year is sure be a big year for the movie industry, and that being said, who knows what movie will be named Best Picture at next years Academy Awards.

Once graduated, she was withdrawn from the drugs and began to feen for them. This caused a major down fall in her life and could have been fatal if she didn't get help. Shows like these are great influences for the younger generation today who want to go out and do stupid things, that could simultaneously

cause them their life. Seeing real people do things that affect them greatly is enlightening to someone going down the wrong path. Reality television has become extremely popular. It went from these shows being absolutely never thought of to being one of the most talked about genres today. Reality shows range in topics from anything about dating

and finding love, real life situations, like addiction, celebrities and their lifestyles, to even health and fitness. For example there is a new reality show about Sarah Palin in Alaska. She was offered one million per show, even though she is no longer the governor or a presidential candidate. Reality television today is much more graphic and contains much sexual

content. All four of the nation's largest TV stations have adapted to the trend. A popular ABC reality TV show, the Bachelor and Bachelorette, help a man or woman look for love. 





ove aside, Drake! There's a new rapper in the game coming out of the streets of Orlando. DJ Nasty's protégé, Kid Famous, has been rapping and singing since he could talk. DJ Nasty, one of hip-hop's biggest producers, is best known for his work with artists such as Lil' Wayne, DJ Khaled, Ludacris and many more. Now added to the list: Kid Famous.

With remixes to "Thinkin' About You" by Mario, Young Money's "Bedrock," and "Down" by Jay Sean, on the radio, Kid is blowing up speakers. Kid and I sat on leather chairs in his recording studio, where all the music-making happens. Wearing "ultra exclusive" (as he says) Creative Recreation sneakers with ultra tight jeans; a black vest over a lime green v-neck and a long chain necklace embedded with a key, Kid definitely has style. As a matter-offact, he actually embraces the name Kid Famous after seeing the clothing line worn by Travis Barker of punkrock band Blink-182. "It was when Travis Barker had that show out." he explains, "and he used to wear Famous, so I saw a Famous shirt at the mall one day, it was the only one, it was black. The only one out, bought it. That's all I wore for a short amount of time. I was literally the only kid in high school to have those clothes."At the age of seven, he found his talent through, believe it or not, karaoke and began free styling. One song in particular was a remake of a Mos Def jam. Soon enough, he wrote his first rap song on the karaoke machine. Now, at eighteen, he's definitely a kid on his way to being famous.

From karaoke to television, Kid describes his dreams, saying, "I always had this vision of me on TRL. It was so real. That's how I knew, this is it, this is what I want to do." You may not be able to see Kid on the now offthe-air Total Request Live, but nowadays you can find him chillin' out with top dogs in the game like DJ Khaled and drinking sangria with Ludacris at his mansion during the Super Bowl. Far from Ludacaris' mansion is where Kid was born and raised in the small town of Casselberry. Music has surrounded Kid throughout his entire life. His father was a professional percussionist and his brother, Izaiah Demarco, is a producer and member of Miami-based music trio, Holliwoodz. Kid says he really looks up to his brother: "He made me want to do it. If he didn't sing, I probably wouldn't sing. We write songs together." Kid also says he does what he does for his father because unfortunately his father's musical career didn't take a lift off, so Kid is picking up where his father left off.

When Kid was younger, he also vearned to be part of his idol DJ Nasty's clan. He would visit their MySpace profiles, hoping he would eventually get noticed, saying he would feel empty if he didn't do music. Two years ago, when Kid was at the tender age of sixteen, his days of hoping were over. A family friend initially introduced Kid to producer Spiff TV, who is Nasty's right hand man. Spiff would bring Kid along to clubs, such as downtown's AKA Lounge. Originally he was intended to be Spiff's artist, but somehow led to a connection with Nasty. Spiff provided Kid with an instrumental, which was supposed to be on Kanye West's album, but wanted to see what Kid could do. Inspired by the beat and being as talented as he is, of course, he killed it. During that time, Kid was facing some hardships in his life when he and his girlfriend at the time broke up. "I started wanting her back but she wasn't having it, so I was emotionally messed up," he recalls. Deciding to take initiative, he used this sad time to put his emotion on paper composing the song, "Stereo."

"It was my first industry beat." says Kid, "So I locked myself in my room and I would come up with different melodies. I didn't even write the song. I would sit there and sing in the mic and just dissect different parts." The song was an apology to his then ex-girlfriend that she can hear through her stereo. Well, if it wasn't for the depressing time in his life, he would've never made the

hit that, according to Kid, Nasty went "ape shit" over, having been even sent to big time hip-hop artist, record producer and entrepreneur, P. Diddy.

After a long battle attempting to shine in the hip-hop world, Kid was invited to KDS Studios

to finally meet one of his idols, Nasty, along with record producers, The Inkredibles, who are also managed by Nasty. Kid says, "I get up there, and I'm real excited because it's my first time meeting him; trying to impress him . . . I see him through the window and he puts his arms up to say 'What's up?' and I was like this is a cool guy. I knew right away, he was gonna be mad chill. I met him and we hit (it) off," Kid said with excitement. Soon after, Kid was officially managed by Nasty and signed to Nasty Beat Makers label. Kid says he was ecstatic.

Following two crazy years, as Kid describes it, he now calls Nasty his big brother and is recognized when he goes places. His first hit on the radio was the remix to "Down" by Jay Sean. "I started getting recognition for that," says Kid. "Everyone started hearing it. People started coming up to me and they kind of recognized me, and the doormen at clubs started knowing me." Influenced by early '90s music, Kid says he doesn't know what he would be doing if it wasn't music. He believes it has been his calling, stating he will devote all his time into it because he feels as though he gets lost in it like


it's another world. "They'll give me a record and I just lock myself in here and I focus. I completely escape from the world. I don't touch my phone. Nothing. That's when I'm in the zone . . . The world does not exist," he said, as we sat in his studio, also shared by his brother. Surrounding us are pictures hung on the wall of musicians such as Jimi Hendrix and even an autographed photo of Alicia Keys. He has an open ear for all different types of music. His iPod ranges from throwback legends like Run DMC to today's artists, likeTaylor Swift, claiming he just appreciates music. He feels inspired by everything around him, from girls to movies, saying he has to be inspired and must be hit by the music for him

"I just live my life with a positive mentality, I'm never upset, I'm never sad. There's no point. I try to look at the positive aspects in life."

to be able to throw it down on paper. Most importantly, he says he feels really stimulated to write music when he watches other artists perform. "I'm just like, I really need to do this, I really need to step it up, or I need to get

out there," said Kid. "Any little thing can inspire me. Any situation; you never know what God is going to hit you with." He describes his music as unique and different from the other artists out there. "I'm really not trying to sound conceited because I'm so humble," he says genuinely, "but like I said I respect everybody for their craft. I'm just different and there's not too many people out there who are different right now. *He hopes to start a trend in the music world, being able to stand out but still fit in the crowds, and "bring all the music in one and just hit everybody," he says. "I just wanna be that kid that blends in everywhere because I really do. I do my street shit - I'm Puerto Rican - I chill with all the Spanish kids. I've got my roots, that's where I get my rhyming abilities from. In high school, I chilled with all the white kids."

Creek cafeterias and cafes on every campus. He





"The faculty members involved in the program decide on books and cast votes for which book will be read." said Sequin. This semester students will be reading "Winterdance" by Gary Paulsen. Eight faculty members

participated in the program last semester with a total of about 900 students involved in the program. "It is yet to be determined the total number of students involved in the program this semester," said student development faculty member Pat Lee. Typically the students who take advantage of the program are those currently enrolled in either English or journalism and mass communications courses, however being enrolled in either class is not necessary to be a part of the program. Students participating in the program can go to book discussions and talk to other students and faculty members who are reading the book. Generally, free food and drinks are provided for students who attend the meetings.

"120 students showed up for the first discussion last semester," said Sequin. "We had to move to the auditorium to make room for everyone." Get Into Reading is open to all students who wish to participate. Students interested in reading "Winterdance" may stop by the student development office to pick up a free copy.
